I repent of pride, haughtiness, criticism, cruelty, and indifference that show up every time I have a judgmental thought or judging statement toward others.

Your Word says to forgive. Your Word says to have love, compassion and mercy for others, and to walk humbly with You. This is the walk that I desire and choose. I surrender all my thoughts, opinions and words to you. Help me to be unoffendable.

Holy Spirit please warn me when I am prone to judge. Give me the gift of discernment. Help me guard my tongue. Help me guard my heart. Pour Your love into me. Help me see others as You see them.

I declare that only God can read a human heart. I declare that only God is the righteous Judge. Please help me train my tongue to encourage others with whatever is kind and good. Give me a grateful heart.

Heavenly Father, I give You my thought life, my heart and my tongue. I ask for a powerful work of grace in my heart. Please remove all hostility and the roots of bitterness. Please take out the strongholds of judgment toward myself and other people.

Holy Spirit, I am trusting You to reveal to me the names of people and organizations that I have judged with my thoughts and words. I bring them to You one by one, beginning with my parents.
